Meeting called to order at 7:00PM

A motion on the floor was made by Lori Newlon to accept the minutes from the December 7, 2009 meeting. David Stair seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Committee Reports:

1. Chaperone – No new information at this time. Drum line and Winter Guard Schedules will be forthcoming. Chaperones will be needed for those trips.
2. Food – Banquet is January 22, 2010 at 7:00PM. The Juniors are in charge of arranging the Banquet. The Juniors will decorate the school cafeteria. There is a \$2.00 cover charge for each person. Desserts and Drinks will be served. Tammy will contact Rachel about the baby pictures for the Seniors. Pins are ordered for the Seniors. Certificates are being created by Tammy.

Fundraising – The dance is February 20th. Tickets need to be sold. Call Lori to get the tickets. It will be at Orlando Gardens. Cost is 50.00 per person or 90 per couple. It is an adult only event. It was suggested to have an e-mail sale of the toilet paper. Have it go out to all the schools and have them come to the school to pick it up. It was suggested to play Christmas Music at Schnucks and Price Chopper next year to get donations.

A majority of the concessions for the Basketball games have been filled.

3. Transportation- The trailer will be needed in 3 weeks. The toilet paper that is left will be redistributed in the trailer so the Winter Guard and Drum Line can place their equipment in the trailer. Key has been transferred to Lori Newlon in order to continue the sales of Toilet Paper in the coming weeks.

Drivers are being lined up for the trailer. A replacement to chair this committee has not been found as of yet.

4. Travel – The schedules for Winter Guard and Drum Line will come out shortly.
5. Uniform - \$500 is still needed to clean the uniforms. All Instrumental students have a blue shirt. The students in these shirts looked professional during the Christmas Concert. Another order for the jackets is being considered for this school year. Next school year the jackets will be part of the uniform. Winter Guard and Drum Line need to arrange for show shirts. There are some uniforms missing. Most are getting pictures taken with them. A summer uniform shirt will be determined at a later date for the DC trip. The Band members 2008-2009 are invited to attend the DC trip but it is necessary to determine the number of alumni that will be attending to make sure there are enough uniforms.
6. Finance – Two outstanding scholarships are still pending.
Regular account has not had a lot of activity.
Winter Guard first half of dues is due Jan. 5 Total cost is \$300
Drum Line first half of dues is due Jan. 5 \$250.
Current Balance is \$413.74 in the General Account.
The Unencumbered Total for the General Account is (9,550.36)
Current Unencumbered Balance for Scholarship is (384.91)
7. Director – Neewollah CD's are still available to be bought.
CD's of the concert in December are available for \$1.00.
Ensemble contest is in March 26; March 27th is the Ensemble festival at Jefferson College, Winter Guard is also competing on that day.
