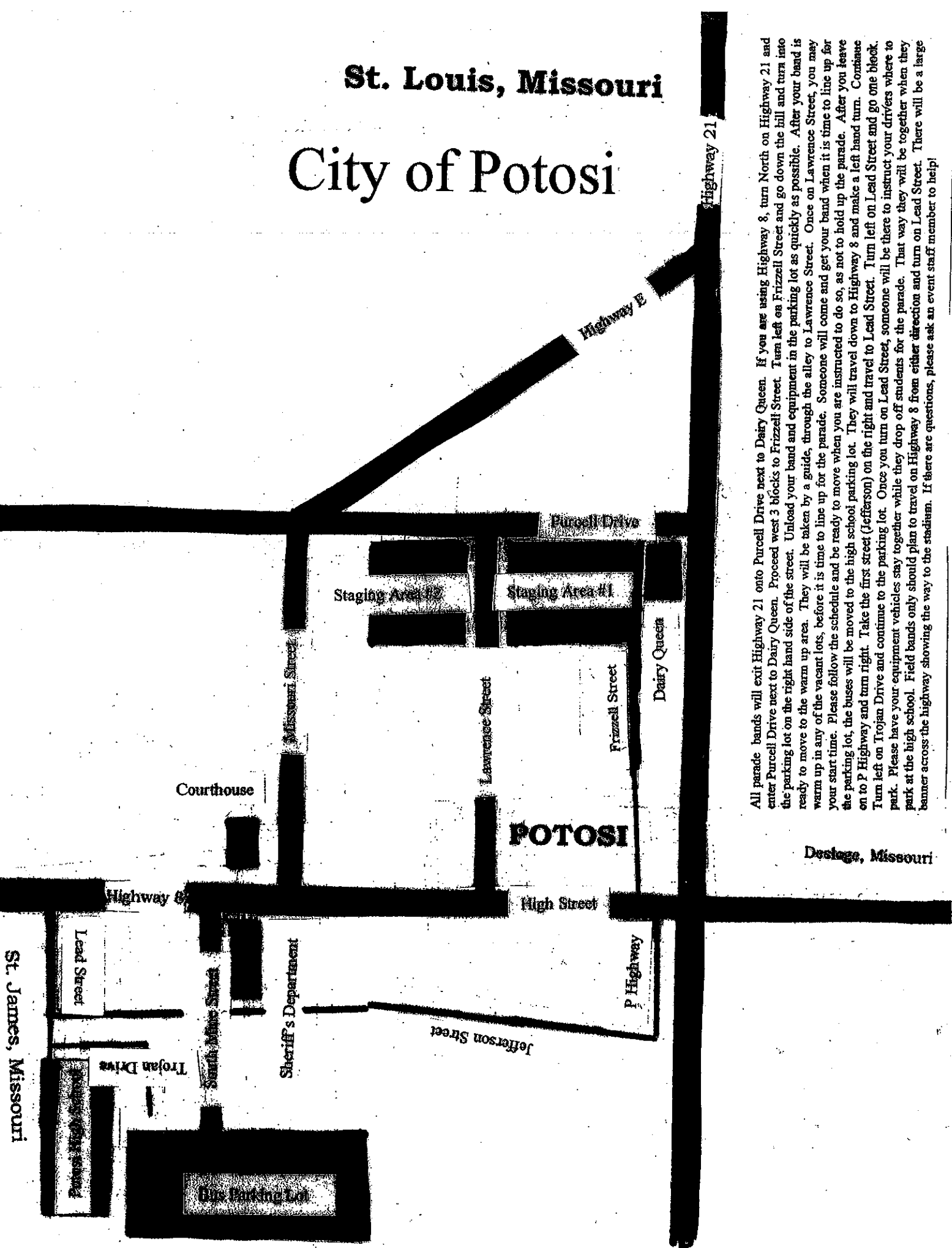

All parade bands will exit Highway 21 onto Purcell Drive next to Dairy Queen. If you are using Highway 8, turn North on Highway 21 and enter Purcell Drive next to Dairy Queen. Proceed west 3 blocks to Frizzell Street. Turn left on Frizzell Street and go down the hill and turn into the parking lot on the right hand side of the street. Unload your band and equipment in the parking lot as quickly as possible. After your band is ready to move to the warm up area. They will be taken by a guide, through the alley to Lawrence Street. Once on Lawrence Street, you may warm up in any of the vacant lots, before it is time to line up for the parade. Someone will come and get your band when it is time to line up for your start time. Please follow the schedule and be ready to move when you are instructed to do so, as not to hold up the parade. After you leave the parking lot, the buses will be moved to the high school parking lot. They will travel down to Highway 8 and make a left hand turn. Continue on to P Highway and turn right. Take the first street (Jefferson) on the right and travel to Lead Street. Turn left on Lead Street and go one block. Turn left on Trojan Drive and continue to the parking lot. Once you turn on Lead Street, someone will be there to instruct your drivers where to park. Please have your equipment vehicles stay together while they drop off students for the parade. That way they will be together when they park at the high school. Field bands only should plan to travel on Highway 8 from either direction and turn on Lead Street. There will be a large banner across the highway showing the way to the stadium. If there are questions, please ask an event staff member to help!

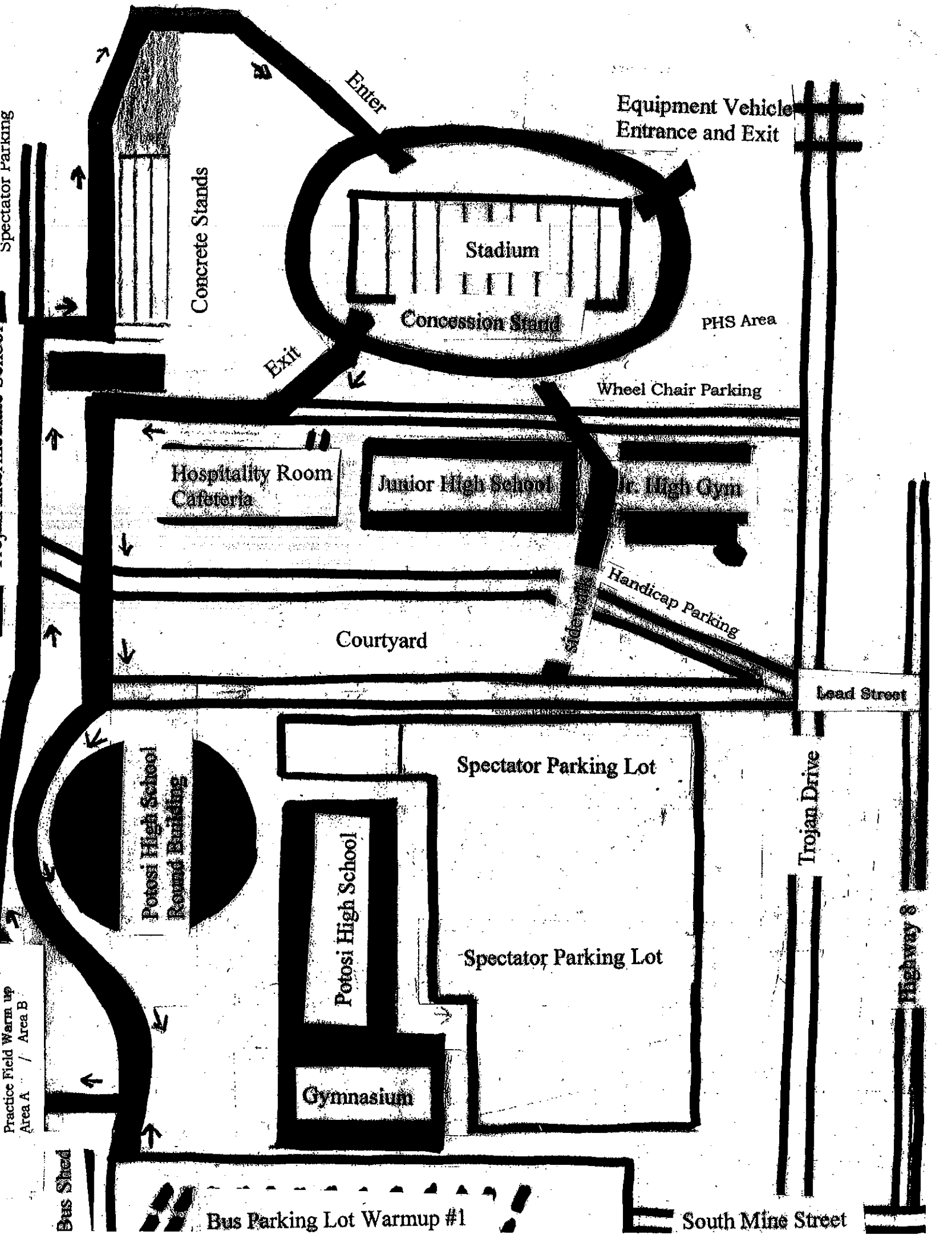
