**UPON ARRIVAL - BUSES MUST LEAVE THE STAGING AREA BY THE WEST 30th STREET BALDWIN SCHOOL EXIT AND TURN LEFT TOWARD STATE STREET. YOUR HOST WILL GUIDE YOU!**

**PLEASE!! FOR SAFETY PURPOSES - ALL MARCHERS (INCLUDING ADULTS) MUST WEAR STREET SHOES WHILE MARCHING IN THE PARADE. PLEASE NO FLIP FLOPS!!!!**  
**AFTER STAMPING - STUDENTS MAY USE OUR RESTROOMS AND THE SENIOR HIGH BUILDING FOR ANY NECESSITIES. BALDWIN SCHOOL IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR USE AND STUDENTS MUST USE THE SENIOR HIGH BUILDING LOCATED IN THE UPPER LOT. YOUR BUS WILL BE DIRECTED TO THE PARADE FINISH LINEUP WHERE THEY WILL PICK UP STUDENTS AFTER THE PARADE at Quincy Junior High. Chaperones will be stamped on the bus. Crew should use wrist bands. A guide will alert you to the JUDGES AT 26th AND MAINE. JUDGES WILL BE ON THE LEFT. PLEASE HAVE YOUR BAND PERFORM AS MANY TIMES AS POSSIBLE DURING THE PARADE. WE HAVE MANY, MANY REQUESTS FOR THE BANDS TO PLAY MORE MUSIC AND HAVE LESS DRUM CADENCES.**

**We know you have similar requests during parades in your cities. THANKS IF YOU CAN HELP!!!!!!**

**FOLLOWING THE PARADE - BUSES SHOULD travel EAST ON STATE STREET (the main thoroughfare SOUTH of MAINE or on MAINE (if parade is finished) BACK to FLINN STADIUM where they will PARK for the FIELD COMPETITION. IF YOU ARRIVE LATE FOR THE PARADE YOU SHOULD ENTER THE BALDWIN SCHOOL PARKING LOT FROM THE SOUTH THROUGH THE 30th STREET ENTRANCE.**

The **OCTOBERFEST FIELD COMPETITION** will be held at **FLINN STADIUM** located at **44th and MAINE STREETS** in **QUINCY, ILLINOIS**, and will begin at 5:15pm. Admission to the event is \$5.00 for Adults and \$4.00 for students (High school and younger).

Participants will be admitted with their **HAND STAMP ONLY**. **DUE TO FIRE REGULATIONS AND CODE, TAILGATING AND TAILGATE PARTIES ARE PROHIBITED ON QUINCY PUBLIC SCHOOL GROUNDS. THANK YOU FOR YOUR COOPERATION.**

### **FIELD SHOW ONLY BANDS**

Marching Bands that are participating in the **FIELD SHOW ONLY** should arrive at **FLINN STADIUM** early. **PLEASE DRIVE BUSES TO THE FRONT TICKET GATE OF FLINN WHERE YOU WILL BE DIRECTED BY GUIDES. PLEASE KEEP ALL STUDENTS ON THE BUS UNTIL A HOST HAS MET YOUR GROUP AND ALL DIRECTORS, STUDENTS, BUS DRIVERS AND CREW MEMBERS HAVE HAD THEIR HAND STAMPED.** THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE FAN BUSES.

We are very proud of our facility here at Quincy High School and pleased to be able to share it with our visitors. Flinn Stadium Field was named the #1 High School Soccer Field in the nation for 1998 TURF Magazine. **PLEASE BE ADVISED** that you will find the field grass **MUCH LONGER** than most fields. **ALSO, NOTHING MAY BE THROWN ON THE FIELD OR USED THAT WILL DISCOLOR OR BURN THE FIELD. ANYTHING USED DURING A FIELD PRESENTATION MUST BE PICKED UP BY YOUR GROUP IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING YOUR PERFORMANCE.**

**Please have your equipment truck and band report to the BAND ENTRANCE GATE (North entrance of the field) at your REPORT TIME. PLEASE KEEP STUDENTS QUIET IN THIS AREA AS ANOTHER GROUP WILL BE PERFORMING ON THE FIELD. YOUR GROUP WILL EXIT THE STANDS ON THE SOUTH SIDE.**

### **FINAL AWARDS PRESENTATION**

We present **ALL FIELD SHOW COMPETITION BANDS** in a **FINALE MARCH** at the end of the Competition. **PLEASE HAVE ALL BANDS LINE UP AT THE SOUTH ENTRANCE OF THE FIELD BY 9:30 PM. EACH BAND WILL BE INTRODUCED AS THEY PASS THE STANDS AND THEN LINE UP ON THE FIELD. AWARDS WILL THEN BE PRESENTED. PARADE ONLY BANDS THAT ARE IN ATTENDANCE SHOULD HAVE THEIR FIELD REPRESENTATIVES IN UNIFORM AND ON THE 50 YARD LINE AT THIS TIME. DIRECTORS ARE ASKED TO LINE UP IN FRONT OF YOUR BANDS TO ACCEPT MUSICIANSHIP AWARDS!**

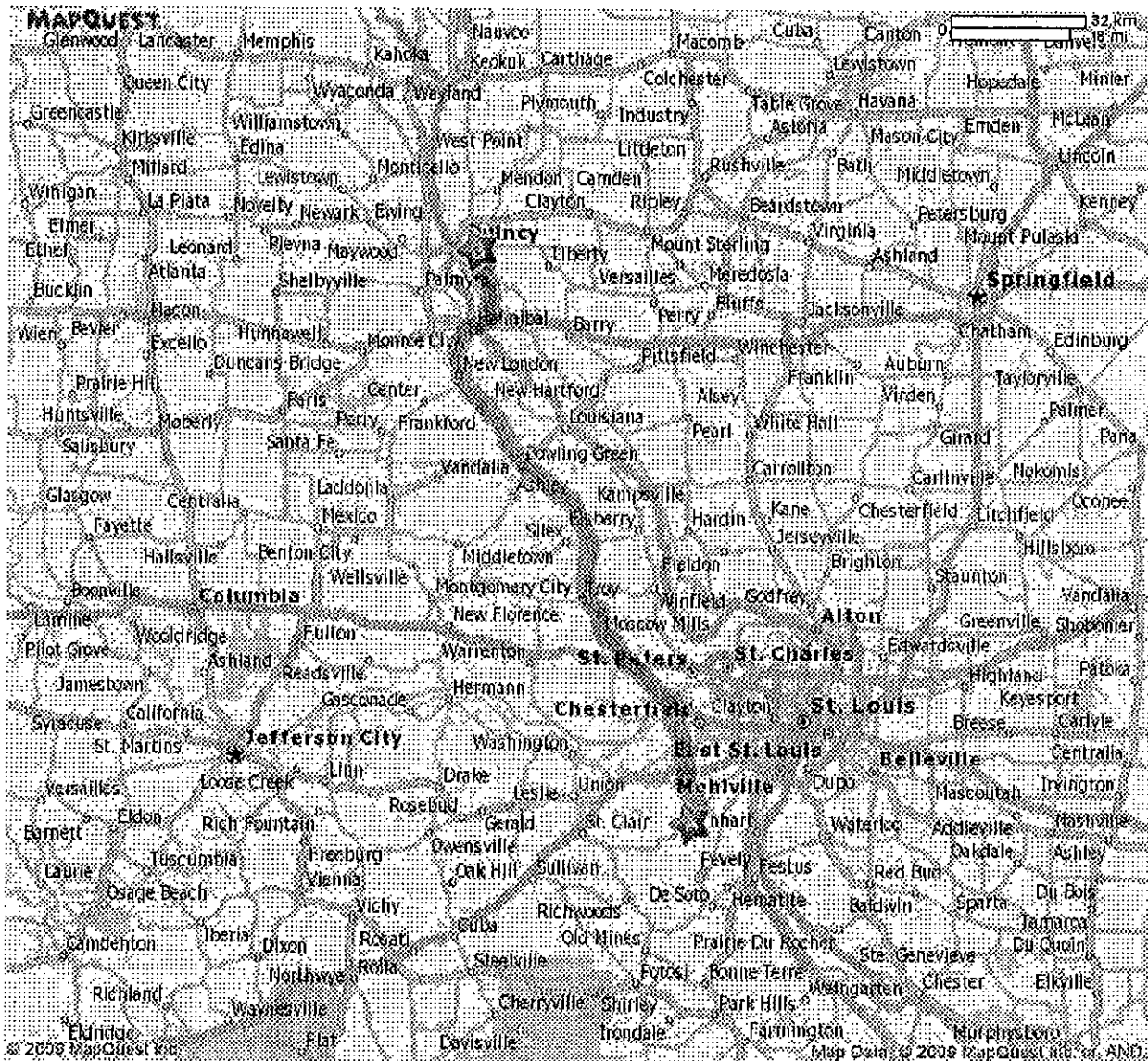
